Mansfield formerly held an appointment as clinical professor of practice at The Ohio State University College of Nursing and served as faculty lead for the graduate nursing administration courses. He is the President of the RWJF-ENF Alumni Association and also holds an appointment as Member, National Advisory Committee of the RWJF Future of Nursing Scholars Program.
