1. Learn how to setup and complete a chart review project
2. Learn how to setup a basic or clinical science project
3. Learn how to write a scientific paper

INSTRUCTIONAL METHODOLOGIES & ROTATION ACTIVITIES:

(Students on this rotation will be expected to learn and achieve the educational goals and objectives through the following methodologies and activities:)

1. The student will spend approximately 40 hour per week in the laboratory. Grade will be determined upon completion of their project and the effort put forth.

PATIENT ENCOUNTERS: (Students will be expected to work-up patients with these specified conditions:)

None – there are no patient encounters in this rotation

EVALUATION / FEEDBACK METHODS:

1 Abstract Submission- Students will be expected to write up their research findings and submit to an otolaryngology meeting of their choice. Validation of their work will occur if it is accepted for presentation at the meeting. The MUSC Department of Otolaryngology-HNS provides \$1000 grants for travel to meetings to make oral presentations of original research. The availability of such funds is subject to change and must be arranged through the research mentor. Preparing an abstract for peer-review for a meeting evaluates Medical Knowledge of the disorder under study and evaluates the authors Communication skills in writing.

2 Manuscript Preparation- The ability of the student to assimilate medical knowledge, pose a research hypothesis, test a research hypothesis, present data, and summarize data in light of existing knowledge will be assessed with a manuscript. The student's work will be validated if the research mentor decides the quality of the work is sufficient to merit submission to a peer-reviewed publication. Manuscript preparation will assess Medical Knowledge, Communication Skills, and Life-Long Learning.

This course is open only to MUSC students. Students will rotate only on the head and neck cancer service. They will not be allowed to rotate on Teams A or B. This rotation qualifies as a surgical AI.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course is an introduction to the evaluation and management of tumors of the head and neck. Students will function as an acting extern and will be responsible for learning the outpatient and inpatient care of patients with tumors of the head and neck. The student will be comfortable with the full head and neck exam, diagnostic evaluation, surgical approaches and perioperative management of head and neck tumor patients. The student will participate in the multidisciplinary head and neck cancer clinic, head and neck tumor board and lectures related to head and neck and general otolaryngology topics. Once the student is proficient in the head and neck outpatient diagnosis, staging and physical examination, the student may become involved and observe surgical procedures for these patients. The student will participate with residents, fellows and attendings in inpatient care, ICU care and operating room care.
