### Directions - Upon arrival

- Students you must arrive early for line up. Go backstage to sign in and pick up your white coat and name badge with a number on it which will indicate your place in line. Please come at the following times:
  - If your last name begins with A-J, please arrive at 12:30 pm
  - If your last name begins with K-Q, please arrive at 1:00 pm
  - If your last name begins with R-Z, please arrive at 1:15 pm
- PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY PERSONAL BELONGINGS (such as purses or bags)
- Proceed to assigned waiting area to get in your general line up (by number) and meet other students.
- You will receive a pin, put it on the left lapel of your white coat. Carry your white coat over your left arm when the class marches in.
- Orientation helpers will assist you in lining up and making sure all names are in correct order.
- Second Year medical students will lead the processional into the auditorium.

### Directions for the Ceremony

- Your class will fill the first rows of the auditorium.
- Following the speaker, each of you will be called in turn to cross the stage.
- Dr. Jeffrey Wong, Senior Associate Dean for Medical Education, will assist you in putting on your white coat. Walk to him, hand him your coat and face the audience to be “coated”. Dr. Jerry Reves, Dean of the College of Medicine will shake your hand to congratulate you.
- Proceed to the second table to receive your stethoscope, given to your by the College of Medicine Alumni Loyalty Fund.
- Return to your seat and be seated.
- When all have received their white coats, Dr. Wong, will ask the class to rise and repeat a version of The Hippocratic Oath.
- At the conclusion of the ceremony, sophomores will lead the recessional. Please go to the reception area and have your family and friends meet you there. The reception will be in the lobby of the Gaillard.
