

**Gamma Omicron At-Large Chapter
Sigma Theta Tau, International
2009 Leadership Intern Program**

The Leadership Intern (LI) program for Gamma Omicron at-Large Chapter was started in 2004. The purpose of the program is to allow 2 new members to learn more about Sigma Theta Tau and leadership opportunities within the local chapter. The LI sits on the board as a non-voting member, assuming various assigned tasks as designated by the President. The process for selection includes an application that describes their interest in STTI leadership and their ability to fulfill the outlined obligations to the chapter. One LI is selected each May by the BOD, to begin in July with the remainder of the new board. The term is for 2 years. Each LI will be sent to the STTI Leadership Academy once during their 2-year term. At the conclusion of their term, the LI agrees to assume a leadership position on the board for a minimum of 1 term. The position can be an officer or committee member and is pending the election by the chapter membership.

Timeline:

February: applications and letters sent to newly inducted members and communicated on webpage

March 30: application deadline

July 1, 2009- June 30, 2011 serve in LI position

2011 Elections- run on ballot for board position

Obligations of LI:

- Be able to attend board meetings
- Be able to assume additional responsibilities as assigned
- Be willing to run for election for a board position at conclusion of their LI term (Officer or Committee member)

Obligations of Chapter:

- Provide mentorship to new member
- Cover the cost to send to the STTI Leadership Academy
