Prior to registering for Mentored Research (NRPHD 971), Mentored Teaching (NRPHD 800), or Special Topics in Nursing Science (NRPHD 723) the student must:

1. Discuss the proposed course with a faculty member. Faculty for Mentored Teaching must have taught at the MUSC CON for a minimum of 2 years and have positive teaching evaluations.
2. Obtain consent of a faculty member (to precept the student) for the proposed course. For Mentored Research the student must work in at least 2 aspects of the research process with a faculty member who is actively engaged in a research project.
3. Complete contract form with a faculty member specifying:
 - a) purpose of the proposed plan
 - b) learning objectives of the course
 - c) evaluation criteria and method - for Mentored Research the student must prepare either a poster or presentation for Student Research Day.
4. Contract form must be signed and dated by the faculty, student and Director of the Doctoral Program.

Once the form has been completed, the student must submit the contract to the Office of Student Services, College of Nursing, room 216. The student and faculty should keep a copy of the contract.

You cannot preregister for 971, 800 or 723 until you and your preceptor have completed and signed this contract.

NOTE: Students must have successfully completed all prerequisites for NRPHD 971, NRPHD 800, or NRPHD 723 before they will be allowed to register for these courses.
