CPT*Web* is a web-based multi-media, training course for mental health providers seeking to learn *Cognitive Processing Therapy* (CPT) for PTSD. CPT*Web* is specifically designed to teach clinicians about using CPT with military and veteran clients. It teaches all of the components of CPT using concise explanations, video demonstrations, and clinical scripts. Common clinical challenges and cultural considerations are discussed for each component.



Learners completing CPT*Web* receive 9 hours of continuing education credit free of charge.

Development of CPT*Web* was funded by the U.S. Navy Bureau of Medicine and Surgery and completed with the cooperation of the developers of CPT.

CPT*Web* was launched in 2010.

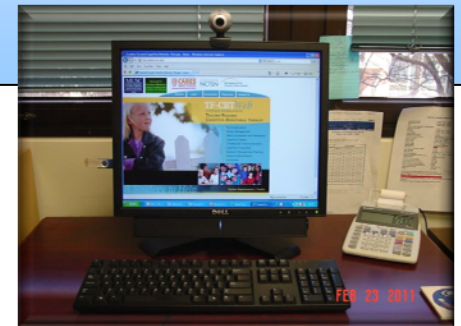

TF-CBT Web is a web-based, multi-media training course for Trauma-Focused Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT). **TF-CBT Web** was developed as part of a National Child Traumatic Stress Network grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration in collaboration with the developers of TF-CBT and other NCTSN centers.

The course has 10 modules that follow the components of TF-CBT. Each module has:

- Concise Explanations
- Video Demonstrations
- Clinical Scripts
- Clinical Challenges
- Cultural Considerations



Learners completing **TF-CBT Web** receive 10 hours of continuing education credit free of charge.

TF-CBT Web was launched in 2005 and has over 98,000 registered learners from 111 countries.

CTG Web is a follow-up training course to **TF-CBT Web** that teaches therapists how to apply TF-CBT to cases of child traumatic grief. It is also web-based, modular, and multimedia. Modules include:

- Adapting TF-CBT to CTG
- Grief Education
- Grieving and Ambivalent Feelings
- Preserving Positive Memories
- Redefining the Relationship

Each module is structured similarly to those of **TF-CBT Web**.



Learners completing **CTG Web** receive 6 hours of continuing education credit free of charge. **CTG Web** is available only to learners who have completed **TF-CBT Web**.

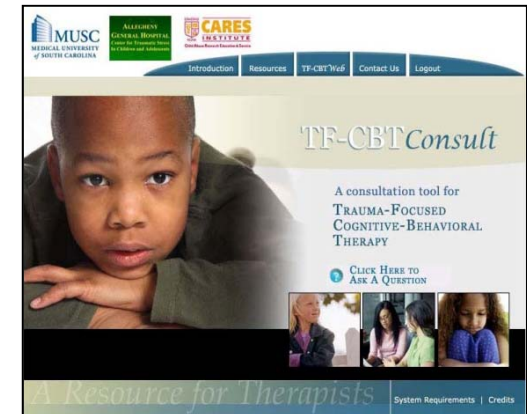
CTG Web was developed in collaboration with the TF-CBT developers and was launched in 2008.

TF-CBT Consult quickly provides online, automated clinical consultation to therapists using TF-CBT. Users can enter a question or set of keywords to screen a long list of commonly asked consultation questions concerning TF-CBT. Answer Pages contain:

- Concise text answers
- Video explanations by the TF-CBT developers
- Video dialogues between TF-CBT experts concerning clinical issues
- Video clinical demonstrations



TF-CBT Consult is available only to learners who have completed **TF-CBT Web**.

Development of **TF-CBT Consult** was funded by the Annie E. Casey Foundation. It was developed in collaboration with the TF-CBT developers and launched in 2010.
