Describe ASIA Classifications to increase understanding of the basic differences in ASIA grades.

Explore strategies and techniques to increase the knowledge base of the practitioner concerning secondary complications and functional treatment techniques for the persons with SCI.

Identify three most common medical complications associated with spinal cord injury.
