

ONLINE-STUDENT LOAN EXIT INTERVIEWS

Dear Graduating Students:

The Student Accounting Office at the Medical University of South Carolina would like to congratulate you on your academic achievements.

Federal law requires all students who receive student loan funds from either federal, state, institutional and/or private lending institutions to complete a loan exit interview before graduating.

Approximately seven weeks before graduation you will receive a letter from Student Accounting with the following information: School Code, your Educational Computer Systems, Inc. (ECSI) Web Pin number and an Indebtedness Report that shows your total loans that you borrowed while attending MUSC. With this information and your Social Security Number you can complete the exit interview by accessing the web site of ECSI at www.ecsi.net. Click on the "Borrower Link" and login to "My Account" by using the information provided in the letter that sent to you.

This exit interview process will take approximately 35 minutes. There are forms to complete and a series of questions. Also, please print a copy of the disclosure statement and the confirmation sheet for your records.

To avoid having a hold placed on your diploma and transcripts, you must complete the exit counseling process at least three weeks before graduation.
