All employees who occupy FTE or research grant positions, regardless of their regular schedules, are entitled to these holidays. Should scheduling problems exist requiring that employees work, compensatory time can be granted. *(Please refer to the Holiday Policy, No. 23, on the MUSC Home Page, Human Resources, University Human Resources, Policies website, or at <http://www.musc.edu/hrm/policies/policy23.html>)*

The Office of Parking Management and University Transportation Services will operate as usual on Veterans' Day, November 11. Employees are asked to park in their usual assigned area on this holiday.
